RESOLUTION: APPROVAL OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION BUDGET

NUMBER 61-B-24 DATE: APRIL 2, 2018

INTRODUCED BY: Alex Stout, Student Senate Information Technology Director

1 WHEREAS, students at University of Wisconsin System institutions are required
2 to pay a fee each year to maintain and enhance technology on their campuses; and

3 WHEREAS, The Student Technology Fee equals two percent of the previous year's
4 tuition costs in accordance with the University of Wisconsin Administrative Policy 815
5 (formerly called System Policy F49); and

6 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin System guidelines require that the student
7 technology fee be spent on technology which is generally accessible to all students; and

8 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission of the University of
9 Wisconsin-Eau Claire, in cooperation with the staff of Learning and Technology Services
10 and McIntyre Library, is charged with making recommendations for the allocation of the
11 Student Technology Fee funds each year; and

12 WHEREAS, fluctuations in the price of hardware and software force the
13 Information Technology Commission to set budget ranges for each category of the
14 Student Technology Fee; and

15 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission has completed its research,
16 review, and budget process for the Fiscal Year 2019 Student Technology Fee budget
17 ranges; and

18 WHEREAS, the commission is working towards a continuation of the thematic
19 goal of incorporating a "Bring Your Own Device" model; and

20 WHEREAS, the commission is continuing to foster recruitment and retention of
21 students through innovative ideas such as Open Eau Claire; and

22 WHEREAS, this budget places an emphasis on innovative technologies in order to
23 accomplish these thematic goals; and

24 WHEREAS, the Information Technology Commission approved these budget
25 ranges by a vote of 7-0-1;

26 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire
27 Student Senate approves the Information Technology Commission's recommendations
28 for the Fiscal Year 2018 Student Technology Fee Budget Ranges (Attachment "A"); and

29 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that upon passage, President McGarry transmit a copy of
30 this bill to Dr. James Schmidt, Chancellor; Dr. Patricia Kleine, Provost/Vice Chancellor;
