1 WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability is responsible for funding projects that
2 incorporate elements of sustainability such as transportation, energy, waste, climate change,
3 water, food systems, campus ecology, education and outreach; and

4 WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire's mission is to "foster in one another
5 creativity, critical insight, empathy and intellectual courage, the hallmarks of a transformative
6 liberal education and the foundation for active citizenship and lifelong inquiry"; and

7 WHEREAS, a makerspace provides a platform for students of all majors and interests to
8 collaborate and innovate for creativity in a variety of fields; and

9 WHEREAS, through collaboration and reusing of tools and materials, waste is minimized
10 during the use of the makerspace, therefore aligning with goals of the Student Office of
11 Sustainability; and

12 WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability in collaboration with the McIntyre Library and
13 the MakeUWEC group would work to create events, presentations and promotional materials to
14 address sustainability in the space; and

15 WHEREAS, by providing access to technology and resources, a makerspace supports the
16 university's commitment to equity and inclusivity; and

17 WHEREAS, the Student Office of Sustainability purchase equipment/tools valued at
18 \$13,119.38 and \$1,620.00 of initial materials totaling \$14,739.38.

19 WHEREAS, Attachment A outlines the makerspace proposal to the Student Office of
20 Sustainability and Attachment B outlines budgetary information

21 BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, The Student Office of Sustainability Green Fund allocates
22 \$14,739.38 to the McIntyre Library for the fulfillment of a makerspace
